Rimu School has a long association with the community and district. The school is located 12 kms southeast of Invercargill city in a country area, which includes both sheep and dairy farming. The school enjoys a positive reputation in the community by providing a positive, safe learning environment for all students and is well supported by the Board of Trustees. The school encourages an active Home & School partnership and a strong parent community supports the school.

The roll is approximately 110 students and is organised into 5 classrooms. A New Entrant/Year 2 class, Year 2/3, Year 3/4, Year 4/5 and Year 6-8 class.

All members of the team have a teaching component to their role. Part time support staff are also employed, these include our teacher aides, office manager and part time Caretaker.
