At Deanwell we use the metaphor of a korowai to explain our vision.

We believe that each person (mokopuna) is born with their own korowai. Their korowai is embedded with their identity, their language, their culture, their stories passed down to them from their ancestors. When our students transition to Deanwell we value and acknowledge their already developing korowai. We feel incredibly privileged that we are then allowed as educators to stimulate and provide learning opportunities where each student can add new knowledge, new strategies, new skills, new feathers to their korowai.

Our inclusive learning pedagogy is based on Hauora - where developing high trust relationships is critical for learning. Relationships in our learning community are based on our values, Hāpaitia te MANA - **Manaakitanga, Aumangea, Ngātahi, Ako**

Deanwell is 100% committed to providing evidence based professional learning and we have high expectations of teachers transferring this learning for the educational benefits of our students.



Our curriculum is based on...

- **Huakina Mai** - is a sociocultural approach to behaviour learning, which resonates with kaupapa Māori theory.
- **Multisensory Structured Language** - is an approach that honours the Science of Reading based on explicit instruction. The Board funds professional learning in MSL.
- **Maths** - as per the New Zealand Curriculum.
- **Te Reo Māori** - we teach two languages at Deanwell; English and te reo Māori.

All our students are to receive a minimum of 3 hours of te reo Māori per week.

As a teacher at Deanwell School you will join our progressive team where we capitalise on individual personalities to strengthen our collective intelligence.


Communication is modelled on autonomy and trust to develop cohesive teams.
